Subject:	Draft Regulation of the European Parliament and of the Council the monitoring and reporting of CO2 emissions from and fuel consumption of new heavy-duty vehicles (first reading) - Adoption of the legislative act

1. On 1 June 2017 the Commission sent the above proposal¹, based on Article 192(1) TFEU, to the Council.
2. The Committee of the Regions was consulted.
3. The European Economic and Social Committee delivered its opinion on 2 March 2018².

4. The European Parliament adopted its position at first reading on the Commission proposal on 12 June 2018. The outcome of voting in the European Parliament reflects the compromise agreement reached between the institutions and should, therefore, be acceptable to the Council³.
5. The Permanent Representatives Committee is therefore asked to confirm its agreement and to suggest that the Council:
 - approve the European Parliament's position, as set out in PE-CONS 20/18, as an "A" item at a forthcoming meeting;
 - order that the statements in the addendum to this note be entered in the minutes of that meeting.

If the Council approves the European Parliament's position, the legislative act will be adopted.

After being signed by the President of the European Parliament and the President of the Council, the legislative act will be published in the Official Journal of the European Union.
