Subject: Proposal for a directive of the European Parliament and of the Council laying down a procedure for the provision of information in the field of technical standards and regulations and of rules on Information Society services (codified text) **(first reading)**
- Adoption of the legislative act (LA)

1. On 26 April 2010, the Commission sent its proposal ¹, based on Article 114 TFEU, to the Council, supplemented by an amended proposal sent to the Council on 20 December 2013 ².
2. The European Economic and Social Committee delivered its opinion on 10 July 2010 ³.
3. The European Parliament adopted its position at first reading on the Commission proposal on 15 April 2014⁴. The Parliament having approved a corrigendum to that position at its plenary session on 15 April 2015, the outcome of voting in the European Parliament reflects the agreement reached between the institutions and should, therefore, be acceptable to the Council.

4. The Permanent Representatives Committee is therefore asked to confirm its agreement and to suggest that the Council approve the European Parliament's position, as set out in PE-CONS 8/15, as an 'A' item at a forthcoming meeting.

If the Council approves the European Parliament's position, the legislative act will be adopted.

After being signed by the President of the European Parliament and the President of the Council, the legislative act will be published in the Official Journal of the European Union.
