Following the notifications by sixteen Member States to the European Parliament, the Council and the Commission on 3 April 2016, the authorisation to proceed with enhanced cooperation referred to in Article 20(2) TEU and Article 329(1) TFEU is deemed to be granted and the provisions on enhanced cooperation apply as from 3 April 2017, in accordance with the third subparagraph of Article 86(1) TFEU.
