- 1. On 29 May 2018 the Commission submitted to Council a proposal on the subject above.
- 2. The Regional Steering Committee, a body composed of representatives of the contracting parties, is responsible for the administration and implementation of the EU-Western Balkans Transport Community.<sup>1</sup> The Committee has met twice so far, in February and June 2018. The adoption of Rules of Procedures by this body shall ensure its proper functioning.
- On 12 June 2018, the <u>Working Party on Land Transport</u> examined the Commission proposal. Following a suggestion by one delegation in respect of the text of the draft Rules of Procedure, the draft Rules were slightly amended.<sup>2</sup>

- 4. In light of the above, the <u>Committee of Permanent Representatives</u> is requested to invite the <u>Council</u>:
  - to adopt the decision establishing the position to be adopted on behalf of the European Union within the Regional Steering Committee of the Transport Community as regards the adoption of the rules of procedure of that committee, as set out in document ST 10158/18 and ADD 1 which has been reviewed by lawyer-linguists.

The text of the decision will be transmitted to the European Parliament for information in accordance with Article 218(10) TFEU.
