Predmet:	Prijedlog direktive Europskog parlamenta i Vijeća o pravnom okviru Unije za carinske prekršaje i sankcije – ishod prvog čitanja u Europskom parlamentu (Strasbourg, od 3. do 6. srpnja 2017.)

I. UVOD

Izvjestiteljica Kaja KALLAS (ALDE-EE) u listopadu 2016. na plenarnoj sjednici Europskog parlamenta predstavila je izvješće s 42 amandmana (amandmani od 1. do 42.) na prijedlog direktive u ime Odbora za unutarnje tržište i zaštitu potrošača.

Glasovanjem na plenarnoj sjednici 25. listopada 2016. usvojena su 42 amandmana te je pitanje potom ponovno upućeno Odboru za unutarnje tržište i zaštitu potrošača, i stoga prvo čitanje Parlamenta¹ nije završeno.

III. GLASOVANJE

Na plenarnoj sjednici 5. srpnja 2017. usvojeno je stajalište u prvom čitanju, u obliku amandmana koji su prethodno odobreni 25. listopada 2016.², čime je završeno prvo čitanje.

Tako izmijenjeni prijedlog Komisije i zakonodavna rezolucija čine stajalište Europskog parlamenta u prvom čitanju. Tekst zakonodavne rezolucije Europskog parlamenta naveden je u Prilogu ovoj napomeni.

Union legal framework for customs infringements and sanctions *I**

European Parliament legislative resolution of 5 July 2017 on the proposal for a directive of the European Parliament and of the Council on the Union legal framework for customs infringements and sanctions (COM(2013)0884 – C8-0033/2014 – 2013/0432(COD))
(Ordinary legislative procedure: first reading)

The European Parliament,

- having regard to the Commission proposal to Parliament and the Council (COM(2013)0884),
 - having regard to Article 294(2) and Article 33 of the Treaty on the Functioning of the European Union, pursuant to which the Commission submitted the proposal to Parliament (C8-0033/2014),
 - having regard to the opinion of the Committee on Legal Affairs on the proposed legal basis,
 - having regard to Article 294(3) and Articles 33 and 114 of the Treaty on the Functioning of the European Union,
 - having regard to the reasoned opinions submitted, within the framework of Protocol No 2 on the application of the principles of subsidiarity and proportionality, by the Lithuanian Parliament and the Swedish Parliament, asserting that the draft legislative act does not comply with the principle of subsidiarity,
 - having regard to the opinion of the European Economic and Social Committee of 21 September 2016³,
 - having regard to Rules 59 and 39 of its Rules of Procedure,
 - having regard to the report of the Committee on the Internal Market and Consumer Protection and the opinion of the Committee on International Trade (A8-0239/2016),
1. Adopts as its position at first reading the text adopted on 25 October 2016⁴;
 2. Calls on the Commission to refer the matter to Parliament again if it replaces, substantially amends or intends to substantially amend its proposal;
 3. Instructs its President to forward its position to the Council, the Commission and the national parliaments.
