**'I/A' ITEM NOTE**

Subject:	Draft Directive of the European Parliament and of the Council on certain permitted uses of works and other subject-matter protected by copyright and related rights for the benefit of persons who are blind, visually impaired or otherwise print-disabled and amending Directive 2001/29/EC on the harmonisation of certain aspects of copyright and related rights in the information society (first reading)
	- Adoption of the legislative act

- On 17 October 2016 the Commission sent its proposal<sup>1</sup>, based on Article 114 TFEU, to the 1. Council.
- 2. The European Economic and Social Committee delivered its opinion on 25 January 2017<sup>2</sup>.
- 3. The European Parliament adopted its position at first reading on the Commission proposal on 6 July 2017. The outcome of voting in the European Parliament reflects the compromise agreement reached between the institutions and should, therefore, be acceptable to the Council<sup>3</sup>.

- 4. The Permanent Representatives Committee is therefore asked to confirm its agreement and to suggest that the Council:
  - approve the European Parliament's position, as set out in PE-CONS 23/17, as an 'A' item at a forthcoming meeting;
  - order that the statement in the <u>addendum</u> to this note be entered in the minutes of that meeting.

If the Council approves the European Parliament's position, the legislative act will be adopted.

After being signed by the President of the European Parliament and the President of the Council, the legislative act will be published in the Official Journal of the European Union.
