- On 23 February 2017, the Commission submitted to the Council a proposal for a Council Regulation amending Regulation (EU) No 216/2013 on the electronic publication of the Official Journal of the European Union<sup>1</sup>.
- The text was first discussed in the meeting of the Working Party on e-Law (e-Law) on 16 May 2017.
- 3. Delegations made comments in writing over the summer of 2017.
- Following the meeting of the Working Party on e-Law (e-Law) on 17 October 2017, comments were integrated into the proposal and a revised text was drawn up<sup>2</sup>.

- 5. Delegations confirmed their agreement on the revised text at the level of the Working Party on e-Law (e-Law) in writing. All expressed scrutiny reservations have been lifted.
- 6. The text has been subjected for revision by the lawyer-linguists of the Council. The resulting text is set out in document 14463/17.
- 7. In light of the above, Coreper/Council is invited to:
  - a) agree in principle on the proposed Regulation, as set out in 14463/17, subject to the consent of the European Parliament;
  - b) decide to forward the draft text of the Regulation as set out in 14463/17 to the European Parliament for consent in accordance with Article 352 TFEU.
