Subject:	Draft REGULATION OF THE EUROPEAN PARLIAMENT AND OF THE COUNCIL on supporting ammunition production (ASAP) (first reading)
	- Adoption of the legislative act

- 1. On 3 May 2023 the <u>Commission</u> submitted its proposal¹, based on Articles 114 and 173(3) TFEU, to the Council.
- 2. The European Economic and Social Committee delivered its opinion on 14 June 2023².
- 3. On 13 July 2023 the <u>European Parliament</u> adopted its position at first reading on the Commission proposal. The outcome of voting in the European Parliament reflects the compromise agreement reached between the institutions and should, therefore, be acceptable to the Council³.

- 4. The <u>Permanent Representatives Committee</u> is therefore asked to:
 - confirm its agreement and to suggest that the <u>Council</u> approve the European
 Parliament's position as set out in PE-CONS 46/23 and the joint statement as set out in the <u>Addendum 1</u> to this note, as an "A" item at a forthcoming meeting, with <u>Greece</u> abstaining;
 - decide to publish the statement set out in <u>Addendum 1</u> in the C series of the *Official Journal of the European Union*.
- 5. The statements for the minutes of the Council meeting are set out in the <u>Addendum 1</u> and <u>Addendum 2</u> to this note.
- 6. If the <u>Council</u> approves the European Parliament's position, the legislative act will be adopted.

After being signed by the Presidents of the European Parliament and of the Council, the legislative act will be published in the *Official Journal of the European Union*.
