## 'A' ITEM NOTE

Subject:	Draft REGULATION OF THE EUROPEAN PARLIAMENT AND OF THE COUNCIL amending Regulation (EU) 2020/2222 to extend the period of validity of safety certificates and licences of railway undertakings operating through the Channel Fixed Link (first reading)
	- Adoption of the legislative act

- 1. On 13 July 2021 the <u>Commission</u> sent its proposal<sup>1</sup>, based on Article 91(1) TFEU, to the Council.
- 2. The <u>European Committee of the Regions</u> was consulted and decided not to give an opinion.
- 3. The <u>European Economic and Social Committee</u> was consulted.
- 4. On 1 September 2021, the <u>Permanent Representatives Committee</u> endorsed the compromise text reached with the European Parliament and authorised the Chair to send a letter to the Chair of the TRAN Committee stating that should the European Parliament adopt its position at first reading in the form set out in that letter, subject to revision by the legal linguists of both institutions, the Council would approve the European Parliament's position and the act shall be adopted in the wording which corresponds to the European Parliament's position.

- 5. The <u>European Parliament</u> adopted its position at first reading on 15 September 2021<sup>2</sup>.
- 6. At its meeting on 15 September 2021, the <u>Permanent Representatives Committee</u> agreed to invite the Council to approve the European Parliament's position at the first reading as set out in PE-CONS 62/21 as an 'A' item at a forthcoming meeting.
- 7. The <u>Council</u> is invited to approve the European Parliament's position at the first reading as set out in PE-CONS 62/21.
- 8. If the <u>Council</u> approves the European Parliament's position, the legislative act will be adopted in the wording which corresponds to the European Parliament's position.

After being signed by the President of the European Parliament and the President of the Council, the legislative act will be published in the *Official Journal of the European Union*.
