Subject:	Draft Regulation of the European Parliament and of the Council amending Regulation (EU, Euratom) No 883/2013, as regards the secretariat of the Supervisory Committee of the European Anti-Fraud Office (OLAF) - Adoption of the legislative act (LA)

---

1. On 4 March 2016 the Commission sent its proposal<sup>1</sup>, based on Article 325 TFEU and Article 106a of the Euratom Treaty, to the Council.
2. The European Parliament adopted its position at first reading on the Commission proposal on 6 July 2016. The outcome of voting in the European Parliament reflects the compromise agreement reached between the institutions and should, therefore, be acceptable to the Council<sup>2</sup>.
3. The Permanent Representatives Committee is therefore asked to confirm its agreement and to suggest that the Council approve the European Parliament's position, as set out in PE-CONS 25/16, as an 'A' item at a forthcoming meeting.
