Subject:	Draft Council Implementing Decision setting out a recommendation on addressing the deficiencies identified in the 2021 evaluation of Ireland on fulfilling the conditions necessary for the application of the Schengen acquis in the field of police cooperation

1. Following the Council's adoption of Regulation (EU) No 1053/2013 establishing an evaluation and monitoring mechanism to verify the application of the Schengen acquis, a team of experts from the Member States and the Commission carried out an evaluation of Ireland in view of fulfilling the conditions necessary for the application of the Schengen acquis in the field of police cooperation in 2021.
2. In accordance with that Regulation, the Commission submitted to the Council a proposal for a Council Implementing Decision setting out a Recommendation designed to address the deficiencies identified in the course of the evaluation and ensure that Ireland fulfils all necessary conditions for the application of the Schengen rules related to police cooperation.

3. The Working Party for Schengen Matters, including the Mixed Committee partners Norway, Iceland, Switzerland and Liechtenstein, approved the proposal for the Council Implementing Decision setting out a Recommendation on 19 July 2022.
 4. The Permanent Representatives Committee is therefore asked to recommend that the Council adopt the draft Council Implementing Decision, as set out in 11954/22, as an 'A' item at a forthcoming meeting.
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
