Subject: Proposal for a Regulation of the European Parliament and of the Council repealing Council Directive 76/621/EEC relating to the fixing of the maximum level of erucic acid in oils and fats and Council Regulation (EC) No 320/2006 establishing a temporary scheme for the restructuring of the sugar industry (**First reading**)  
- Adoption of the legislative act (**LA**)

---

1. On 22 April 2015 the Commission sent its proposal<sup>1</sup>, based on Article 43(2) of the TFEU, to the Council.
2. The European Economic and Social Committee delivered its opinion on 1 July 2015<sup>2</sup>.
3. The European Parliament adopted its position at first reading on the Commission proposal on 27 October 2015. The outcome of voting in the European Parliament reflects the compromise agreement reached between the institutions and should, therefore, be acceptable to the Council<sup>3</sup>.
4. The Special Committee on Agriculture is therefore asked to confirm its agreement and to suggest that the Council approve the position of the European Parliament, as set out in PE-CONS 53/15, as an "A" item at a forthcoming meeting.

After being signed by the President of the European Parliament and the President of the Council, the legislative act will be published in the Official Journal of the European Union.
