Subject :	Proposal for a Directive of the European Parliament and of the Council amending Directive 2003/88/EC concerning certain aspects of the organisation of working time [first reading]

- On 23 June 2004 <u>the Commission</u> submitted to the Council the above proposal<sup>1</sup>, based on Article 137(2) of the TEC.
- <u>The European Economic and Social Committee</u> delivered its opinion on 11 May 2005<sup>2</sup>.
   <u>The Committee of the Regions delivered its opinion on 14 April 2005<sup>3</sup></u>.
- 3. <u>The European Parliament</u> delivered its opinion at first reading on 11 May 2005<sup>4</sup>.

- <u>The Commission</u> submitted an amended proposal<sup>1</sup>, under Article 250(2) of the EC Treaty, on 31 May 2005.
- 5. At its 2733rd meeting on 1 and 2 June 2006, <u>the EPSCO Council</u> reached political agreement on a common position concerning the above proposal for a Directive.
- 6. <u>The Permanent Representatives Committee</u> is invited to suggest that the Council:
  - adopt the common position set out in 10597/08 and the statement of reasons set out in 10597/08 ADD 1 COR 1 + COR 2 as an "A" item at a forthcoming meeting, with the Belgian, Cypriot, Greek, Hungarian, Maltese and Portuguese delegations abstaining and the Spanish and Greek delegations voting against;
  - order the statements in the <u>Addendum</u> hereto to be entered in the minutes of that meeting.
