| Subject: | Draft DIRECTIVE OF THE EUROPEAN PARLIAMENT AND OF THE COUNCIL on uniform procedures for checks on the transport of dangerous goods by road (codification) <b>(first reading)</b><br>- Adoption of the legislative act |

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1. On 19 August 2021 the Commission sent its proposal<sup>1</sup>, based on Article 91 TFEU, to the Council.
2. The European Economic and Social Committee delivered its opinion on 20 October 2021<sup>2</sup>.
3. The European Committee of the Regions was consulted and decided not to issue an opinion.
4. On 13 September 2022 the European Parliament adopted its position at first reading on the Commission proposal. The outcome of voting in the European Parliament reflects the compromise agreement reached between the institutions and should, therefore, be acceptable to the Council<sup>3</sup>.

5. The Permanent Representatives Committee is therefore asked to confirm its agreement and to suggest that the Council approve the European Parliament's position, as set out in PE-CONS 22/22, as an "A" item at a forthcoming meeting.
6. If the Council approves the European Parliament's position, the legislative act will be adopted.

After being signed by the Presidents of the European Parliament and of the Council, the legislative act will be published in the *Official Journal of the European Union*.

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
