- On 3 April 2020 the <u>Commission</u> sent its proposal<sup>1</sup>, based on Article 207(2) TFEU, to the Council.
- On 11 November 2020 the <u>European Parliament</u> adopted its position at first reading on the Commission proposal. The outcome of voting in the European Parliament reflects the compromise agreement reached between the institutions and should, therefore, be acceptable to the Council<sup>2</sup>.
