## **DRAFT MINUTES**<sup>1</sup>

Subject: **3488th** meeting of the Council of the European Union (Economic and Financial Affairs), held in Luxembourg on 11 October 2016

## In 13149/16 INIT, on page 3, the paragraph on item 3should read as follows:

<u>Ministers</u> were debriefed on the state of play and exchanged views on whether to include VAT fraud in the scope of the PIF directive, with a view to help JHA Council unlocking negotiations with the European Parliament on this matter. <u>Most ministers</u> expressed an openness to compromise but with some conditions, among which notably a limitation to most serious cases of cross-border VAT fraud. <u>Several ministers</u> expressed their opposition to such inclusion, whilst some suggested including VAT fraud in the scope of the European Public Prosecutor Office (EPPO) Regulation rather than in the PIF Directive. <u>Some ministers</u> also referred to the legislative proposal for a generalised reverse charge mechanism. The Commission assured them that it would submit the legislative proposal by the end of 2016. <u>The Presidency</u> concluded that it would report on the outcome of this exchange of views to the JHA Council.
