- On 1 February 2018 the Commission sent its proposal<sup>1</sup>, based on Article 114 TFEU, to the 1. Council.
- 2. The European Economic and Social Committee delivered its opinions on 23 May 2018<sup>2</sup> and on 27 April 2021<sup>3</sup>.
- 3. The Committee of the Regions was consulted and decided not to issue an opinion.
- 4. The European Parliament adopted its position at first reading on 14 February 2019<sup>4</sup>.

- 5. On 30 June 2021, the Permanent Representatives Committee confirmed the final compromise text on the above draft Regulation<sup>5</sup>.
- 6. The Permanent Representatives Committee is asked to suggest that the Council adopt its position at first reading, as set out in document 10531/21, and the statement of reasons, as set out in document 10531/21 ADD 1 + COR 1, as an 'A' item at a forthcoming meeting, with Bulgaria and Poland abstaining.
- 7. The statements for the minutes of the Council meeting are set out in the Addendum 1 to this note.
