Subject:	Proposal for a REGULATION OF THE EUROPEAN PARLIAMENT AND OF THE COUNCIL on ENISA, the "Cybersecurity agency", and repealing Regulation (EU) 526/2013, and on Information and Communication Technology cybersecurity certification ("Cybersecurity Act") - Optional consultation of the Committee of the Regions

- On 13 September 2017, the <u>Commission</u> submitted to the Council a proposal for a Regulation of the European Parliament and of the Council on ENISA, the "Cybersecurity agency", and repealing Regulation (EU) 526/2013, and on Information and Communication Technology cybersecurity certification ("Cybersecurity Act")¹.
- 2. In its proposal, the Commission suggests that the <u>Committee of the Regions</u> be consulted on an optional basis².

² The sole purpose of this note is to decide on the consultation of another institution/body and not on the substance.

- 3. Article 114 of the Treaty on the Functioning of the European Union, on which the proposal is based, does not require the opinion of the Committee of the Regions.
- 4. Nevertheless, given the subject matter of the proposal, it is considered appropriate to follow the suggestions of the Commission and to consult the Committee of the Regions on an <u>optional basis</u>.
- 5. The <u>Permanent Representatives Committee</u> is therefore invited to decide, in accordance with Articles 304 and 307 of the Treaty on the Functioning of the European Union and Article 19(7)(h) of the Council's Rules of Procedure³, to consult the Committee of the Regions on the above proposal and to request them to give their opinion as soon as possible.
