Subject:	Proposal for a COUNCIL DECISION amending Council Decision No 189/2014/EU authorising France to apply a reduced rate of certain indirect taxes on 'traditional' rum produced in Guadeloupe, French Guiana, Martinique and Réunion and repealing Decision No 2007/659/EC

- 1. On 9 June 2017, the <u>Commission</u> submitted the above-mentioned proposal to the Council.
- On 3 July 2017, <u>the Working Party on Outermost Regions</u> examined the proposal. All delegations agreed to the proposal as amended by the Council Legal Service<sup>1</sup>.
- 3. On 24 October 2017, the <u>European Parliament</u> adopted its opinion on the proposal without suggesting any amendment<sup>2</sup>.
