<u>The Council</u> confirmed the general approach on the proposed Regulation, as set out in doc. 13209/15 and agreed to mandate the Presidency to conduct negotiations with the European Parliament on the basis of the agreed general approach with a view to reaching a pre-negotiated second reading agreement.

<u>The Council</u> confirmed that it could not accept all the amendments adopted by the European Parliament concerning the Council's position on the draft budget for 2016, in accordance with Article 314(4)(c) of the Treaty on the Functioning of the European Union.

<u>The Council</u> held a policy debate on the above-mentioned Commission proposal on the basis of three questions prepared by the Presidency and contained in the annex to doc. 12768/15.

<u>Delegations</u> welcomed the Commission proposal as a necessary first step in the process of translating into legislation the EU objective - as agreed by the October 2014 European Council - of reducing the EU's greenhouse gas emissions by at least 40% domestically by 2030 compared to 1990. <u>Ministers</u> also agreed that the EU emissions trading system was a cornerstone of the EU's climate policy. <u>The President</u> thanked the delegations for their contributions to a rich and interesting debate.

The contributions will provide political guidance for further work on the file within the Council.
