## **'I/A' ITEM NOTE**

Subject:	Draft REGULATION OF THE EUROPEAN PARLIAMENT AND OF THE COUNCIL on European business statistics, repealing 10 legal acts in the field of business statistics (first reading)
	- Adoption of the legislative act

- 1. On 6 March 2017 <u>the Commission</u> sent its proposal<sup>1</sup>, based on Article 338(1) TFEU, to the Council.
- 2. On 16 April 2019, the <u>European Parliament</u> adopted its position at first reading on the Commission proposal (without legal linguistic revision). After finalisation of the adopted text by the legal linguists, the Parliament approved a corrigendum to that position at its plenary session from 21 to 24 October 2019. It reflects the compromise agreement reached between the institutions and should, therefore, be acceptable to the Council<sup>2</sup>.

- 3. The <u>Permanent Representatives Committee</u> is therefore asked to confirm its agreement and to suggest that the <u>Council</u>:
  - approve the European Parliament's position, as set out in PE-CONS 81/19, as an
    "A" item at a forthcoming meeting, with the <u>Czech Republic</u>, <u>Hungary</u> and the <u>United Kingdom</u> abstaining;
  - decide that the statement in <u>Addendum 1</u> to this note be entered in the minutes of that meeting.

If the Council approves the European Parliament's position, the legislative act will be adopted.

After being signed by the President of the European Parliament and the President of the Council, the legislative act will be published in the Official Journal of the European Union.
