- On 13 July 2017, the <u>Commission</u> submitted to the Council and the European Parliament a
 Proposal for a Regulation of the European Parliament and of the Council on Controls on the
 import of cultural goods.
- 2. The Working Party on Customs Union examined this proposal at various meetings in 2017 and 2018. Following a meeting of the Working Party on 29 October 2018, a compromise text, as laid down in doc. ST 13603/1/18 REV 1 UD 257 ENFOCUSTOM 210 EF 276 ECOFIN 988 JAI 1052 CULT 127 COSI 230 COTER 147 RELEX 902 DROIPEN 167 COPEN 363 CODEC 1813, was supported by a majority of delegations¹.
