<u>The Presidency</u> gave some feedback on the progress made at last trilogue on 18 October and asked guidance on political issues specified in the Presidency flash (seeds, databases, empowerment on wine, tethering, mutilation and non-organic juveniles). On most of the issues, the views of delegations were divided. But a number of delegations expressed their support to the compromises on mutilation and tethering, as suggested in the flash by the Presidency.

<u>The Presidency</u> took note of the comments made by delegations and the Commission. The Presidency will take on board the orientation given by the SCA in view of the future negotiations.
