Since the Committee unreservedly endorses the content of the proposal and has already set out its views on the subject in its earlier opinions, namely SOC/545 – *Protection from cancer-causing chemicals*, adopted on 21 September 2016, SOC/559 – *Protection of workers from carcinogens or mutagens at work*, adopted on 31 May 2017, SOC/591 – *Protection of workers from carcinogens or mutagens at work*, adopted on 19 September 2018, and CCMI/130 – *Freeing the EU from asbestos*, adopted on 18 February 2015<sup>1</sup>, it decided, at its 556th plenary session of 2 and 3 December 2020, by 224 votes with 6 abstentions, to issue an opinion endorsing the proposed text and to refer to the position it had taken in the above-mentioned documents.
