Subject: Draft Regulation of the European Parliament and of the Council  
establishing the Body of European Regulators for Electronic  
Communications (BEREC) and the Agency for Support for BEREC  
(BEREC Office), amending Regulation (EU) 2015/2120 and repealing  
Regulation (EC) No 1211/2009 (**first reading**)  
- Adoption of the legislative act

---

1. On 14 September 2016 the Commission sent the above proposal<sup>1</sup>, based on Article 114 TFEU, to the Council.
2. The European Economic and Social Committee delivered its opinion on 25 January 2017<sup>2</sup>.

3. On 14 November 2018 the European Parliament adopted its position at first reading on the Commission proposal. The outcome of voting in the European Parliament reflects the compromise agreement reached between the institutions and should, therefore, be acceptable to the Council<sup>3</sup>.
4. The Permanent Representatives Committee is therefore asked to confirm its agreement and to suggest that the Council
  - approve the European Parliament's position, as set out in PE-CONS 51/18, as an "A" item at a forthcoming meeting;
  - order that the statement in the addendum 1 to this note be entered in the minutes of that meeting.

If the Council approves the European Parliament's position, the legislative act will be adopted.

After being signed by the President of the European Parliament and the President of the Council, the legislative act will be published in the Official Journal of the European Union.
