Subject: **3496th** meeting of the Council of the European Union
(**Foreign Affairs/Trade**), held in Brussels on 11 November 2016

In 14340/16 INIT, on page 7, the 4th paragraph of the statement by Greece should read as follows:

Greece believes that the “factual indicators” referred to in recital no.13 of this proposal cannot be adequately substantiated. The repeated mention of what is 'justified to expect' (**recital no.5**); what 'appears justified' (recital no.12); as well as of those 'who may reasonably be expected to seek to move irregularly to other Member states' (explanatory memorandum, p.3) proves that the proposal is based on speculations and lacks the necessary reasoning for prolonging temporary border controls in accordance with article 29 of the SBC.
