<u>Ministers</u> stressed, among other things, the need to enhance cross-sectoral co-operation in particular involving youth, education, sport, culture, employment and social affairs, and to promote European values in order to prevent the spread of fear and enhance tolerance. The role of youth work in the integration process at local level was highlighted, with the EU Work Plan for Youth facilitating the exchange of best practices in this regard among the Member States.

<u>Ministers</u> condemned the destruction of cultural heritage in Syria, Iraq and other conflict areas, highlighting the link between illicit trafficking in cultural objects and the financing of the terrorist activities of ISIL/Da'esh.

A number of policy options were raised including the adoption of an EU regulation on the import of cultural goods from third countries, better co-operation with UNESCO, better training for customs officers, proper return of illegally-traded goods post-conflict, use of digitisation to facilitate restoration and recovery of cultural goods, a possible role for EUROPEANA, and the possible designation of 2018 as the European Year of Cultural Heritage.
