Subject:	Draft Council Implementing Decision setting out a recommendation on addressing the deficiencies identified in the 2019 evaluation of the <b>Czech Republic</b> on the application of the Schengen acquis in the field of <b>data protection</b>

1. Following the Council's adoption of Regulation (EU) No 1053/2013 establishing an evaluation and monitoring mechanism to verify the application of the Schengen acquis, a team of experts from the Member States and the Commission carried out an evaluation of the Czech Republic on the application of the Schengen acquis in the field of data protection in 2019.
2. In accordance with that Regulation, the Commission submitted to the Council a proposal for a Council Implementing Decision setting out a Recommendation designed to address the deficiencies identified in the course of the evaluation and ensure that the Czech Republic applies all Schengen rules related to data protection correctly and effectively.

3. The Working Party for Schengen Matters (Evaluation), including the Mixed Committee partners Norway, Iceland, Switzerland and Liechtenstein, approved the proposal for the Council Implementing Decision setting out a Recommendation on 27 November 2019.
  4. The Permanent Representatives Committee is therefore asked to recommend that the Council adopt the draft Council Implementing Decision, as set out in 14661/19, as an 'A' item at a forthcoming meeting.
