- On 12 June 2018, the <u>Commission</u> submitted to the Council and the European Parliament a
  Proposal for a Regulation of the European Parliament and of the Council establishing, as part
  of the Integrated Border Management Fund, the instrument for financial support for customs
  control equipment.
- The Working Party on Customs Union examined this proposal at various meetings in 2018
   and reached a compromise supported by <u>a majority of delegations</u> on 17 December 2018. The
   <u>DK delegation</u> informed that they are not in a position to support the text.
- 3. Against this background, the Permanent Representatives Committee is invited to provide the Presidency with a mandate to enter into informal negotiations with the Parliament, on the basis of the text set out in doc. ST 15513/18.
