Subject:	Exchange of EU classified information (EUCI) with third States and international organisations

1. Delegations will find attached for information details of agreements concluded by the EU and of administrative arrangements entered into by the Secretary-General of the Council under which EU classified information (EUCI) may be exchanged with third States and international organisations:

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- 2. The agreements or arrangements listed in Annexes I, II and III provide the necessary guarantees for the protection of EUCI released to third parties relating to any area of the Union's activity. The tables in these annexes list the documents which constitute the basis for exchanging EU classified information with each third State or international organisation, and indicate the maximum level of EUCI which may be exchanged. Where electronic transmission of EUCI is possible, the maximum level releasable in this way is also indicated. However, specific conditions usually apply which may vary from agreement to agreement. These can be verified with the GSC Security Office (Protection of EUCI Unit).
- 3. Annex IV lists the framework agreements concluded or under negotiation with third States governing their participation in present or future CSDP operations. Annex V lists *ad hoc* agreements or arrangements with third States which constitute the legal framework allowing the release of EUCI in a specific CSDP operation.
- 4. Should any need arise exceptionally for EUCI to be released by the Council to any third State or international organisation not covered by existing agreements or arrangements, the procedure for doing so, involving consultation of the Council Security Committee and a decision by COREPER, is set out in the Council's security rules (Annex VI, Section VI).
- 5. The Council, the Commission and the EEAS may only release EUCI to third States and international organisations via the respective competent registries of the Council, the Commission and the EEAS.
- 6. This note replaces doc. 9954/14.

This is based on the undertaking, set out in the agreements, that the third States in question will handle EUCI in accordance with the Council's Security Rules. No electronic transmission of EUCI is permitted. Delegation of release authority to the High Representative is usually given in the Council Decision establishing each specific operation.

European Union military operation to contribute to the deterrence, prevention and repression of acts of piracy and armed robbery off the Somali coast (Atalanta) Council Joint Action 2008/851/CFSP (OJ L 301, 12.11.2008, p 33)

The Joint Action establishing operation Atalanta authorises the release of EUCI and documents generated for the purposes of the operation. Each participation agreement provides that the third State in question will handle EUCI in accordance with the Council's security rules. The Council security rules provide that the maximum level of EUCI which may be exchanged is CONFIDENTIEL UE/EU CONFIDENTIAL for military CSDP operations. No electronic transmission of EUCI is permitted under a framework participation agreement.
