Subject: Draft Regulation of the European Parliament and of the Council replacing Annexes A and B to Regulation (EU) 2015/848 on insolvency proceedings **(first reading)**
- Adoption of the legislative act **(LA)**

1. On 30 May 2016 the Commission sent its proposal¹, based on Article 81 TFEU, to the Council^{2 3 4}.
2. The European Parliament adopted its position at first reading on the Commission proposal on 14 December 2016. The outcome of voting in the European Parliament reflects the compromise agreement reached between the institutions and should, therefore, be acceptable to the Council⁵.

3. The Permanent Representatives Committee is therefore asked to confirm its agreement and to suggest that the Council approve the European Parliament's position, as set out in PE-CONS 52/16, as an 'A' item at a forthcoming meeting.

If the Council approves the European Parliament's position, the legislative act will be adopted.

After being signed by the President of the European Parliament and the President of the Council, the legislative act will be published in the Official Journal of the European Union.
