Subject:	Proposal for a Regulation of the European Parliament and of the Council on certain procedures for applying the Stabilisation and Association Agreement between the European Union and the European Atomic Energy Community, of the one part, and Kosovo* of the other part
	<ul> <li>Adoption of the legislative act (LA + S)</li> </ul>

- On 18 July 2016 <u>the Commission</u> sent its proposal<sup>1</sup>, based on Article 207 TFEU, to the Council.
- <u>The European Parliament</u> adopted its position at first reading on the Commission proposal on 19 January 2017. The outcome of voting in the European Parliament reflects the compromise agreement reached between the institutions and should, therefore, be acceptable to the Council<sup>2</sup>.

- 3. The Permanent Representatives Committee is therefore asked to confirm its agreement and to suggest that the Council:
  - approve the European Parliament's position, as set out in PE-CONS 56/16, as an
     'A' item at a forthcoming meeting, with the Spanish, Romanian and Cyprus delegations abstaining;
  - order that the statements in the <u>addendum</u> to this note be entered in the minutes of that meeting.

If the Council approves the European Parliament's position, the legislative act will be adopted.

After being signed by the President of the European Parliament and the President of the Council, the legislative act will be published in the Official Journal of the European Union.
