	= intention not to raise objections to a delegated act

- 1. <u>The Commission</u> submitted the above delegated act to the Council in accordance with the procedure set out in Article 290 TFEU and Article 301a of Directive 2009/138/EC¹,
- 2. In accordance with Article 301a(5) of Directive 2009/138/EC, the Council may object to this delegated act within a period of three months, i.e. until 26 February 2016.
- No objections were raised by delegations during the silence procedure which expired on <u>1 February 2015.</u>

4. It is therefore suggested that <u>Coreper</u> recommend that <u>the Council</u> confirm that it has no intention to object to the delegated act and that the Commission and the European Parliament are to be informed thereof. This implies that, unless <u>the European Parliament</u> objects to it, the delegated act shall be published and enter into force in accordance with Article 301a(5) of Directive 2009/138/EC.
