#### **'I/A' ITEM NOTE**

Subject: Draft Regulation of the European Parliament and of the Council amending Regulation (EU) No 952/2013 laying down the Union Customs Code (**first reading**)  
- Adoption of the legislative act

---

1. On 8 May 2018 the Commission sent the above proposal<sup>1</sup>, based on Articles 33, 114 and 207 TFEU, to the Council.
2. The European Economic and Social Committee delivered its opinion on 12 July 2018<sup>2</sup>.
3. On 31 January 2019 the European Parliament adopted its position at first reading on the Commission proposal. The outcome of voting in the European Parliament reflects the compromise agreement reached between the institutions and should, therefore, be acceptable to the Council<sup>3</sup>.

4. The Permanent Representatives Committee is therefore asked to confirm its agreement and to suggest that the Council approve the European Parliament's position, as set out in PE-CONS 80/18, as an "A" item at a forthcoming meeting.

If the Council approves the European Parliament's position, the legislative act will be adopted.

After being signed by the President of the European Parliament and the President of the Council, the legislative act will be published in the Official Journal of the European Union.
