The Mission of Iceland to the European Union presents its compliments to the General Secretariat of the Council of the European Union and has the honor to refer to the Agreement concluded by the Council of the European Union and the Republic of Iceland and the Kingdom of Norway concerning the latters' association with the implementation, application and development of the Schengen Acquis, signed on 18 May 1999.
