Subject:	Proposal for a Regulation of the European Parliament and of the Council implementing the anti-circumvention mechanism provided for in the Association Agreement between the European Union and the European Atomic Energy Community and their Member States, of the one part, and Georgia, of the other part ( <b>First reading</b> ) Adoption of the legislative act ( <b>LA</b> )

1. On 14 April 2015 the Commission sent its proposal<sup>1</sup>, based on Article 207(2) of the TFEU, to the Council.
2. The European Parliament adopted its position at first reading on the Commission proposal on 3 February 2016. The outcome of voting in the European Parliament reflects the compromise agreement reached between the institutions and should, therefore, be acceptable to the Council<sup>2</sup>.
3. The Permanent Representatives Committee is therefore asked to confirm its agreement and to suggest that the Council approve the European Parliament's position, as set out in PE-CONS 74/15, as an 'A' item at a forthcoming meeting.

If the Council approves the European Parliament's position, the legislative act will be adopted.
