Subject: Proposal for a DECISION OF THE EUROPEAN PARLIAMENT AND OF THE COUNCIL on providing macro-financial assistance to Ukraine  
**(first reading)**  
- Adoption of the legislative act  
- Decision to derogate from the eight-week period provided for in Article 4 of Protocol 1 on the role of national parliaments in the EU

---

1. On 1 February 2022, the Commission<sup>1</sup> sent its proposal, based on Article 212 TFEU, to the Council.
2. On 16 February 2022, the European Parliament adopted its position at first reading on the Commission proposal. The outcome of voting in the European Parliament reflects the agreement reached between the institutions and should, therefore, be acceptable to the Council<sup>2</sup>.

3. The Permanent Representatives Committee is therefore asked to confirm its agreement and to suggest that the Council:
- approve the European Parliament's position as set out in PE-CONS 5/22 as an 'A' item at a forthcoming meeting;
  - derogate, on the basis of Article 3(3), second subparagraph, of the Council's Rules of Procedure, from the eight-week period referred to in the first subparagraph of that Article, in view of the urgency of the matter as set out in the preamble of the legislative act.
4. At the same time, the Permanent Representatives Committee is invited to decide, in accordance with Article 12(1), first subparagraph, of the Council's Rules of Procedure and Article 1 of Council Decision (EU) 2021/2098<sup>3</sup>, that the Council use the written procedure for the adoption of the abovementioned Decision if no Council meeting with a quorum takes place before 24 February 2022.
5. If the Council approves the European Parliament's position, the legislative act will be adopted.

After being signed by the President of the European Parliament and the President of the Council, the legislative act will be published in the *Official Journal of the European Union*.
