Subject: Proposal for a Regulation of the European Parliament and of the Council on the measures that the Union may take following a report adopted by the WTO Dispute Settlement Body concerning anti-dumping and anti-subsidy matters (codification) (**first reading**)
- Adoption of the legislative act (**LA**)

1. On 28 May 2014 the Commission sent the above proposal¹, based on Article 207(2) TFEU, to the Council.
2. The European Economic and Social Committee delivered its opinion on 10 December 2014.
3. The European Parliament adopted its position on the Commission proposal at first reading on 11 February 2015. The outcome of voting in the European Parliament reflects the compromise agreement reached between the institutions and should, therefore, be acceptable to the Council².

4. The Permanent Representatives Committee is therefore asked to confirm its agreement and to suggest that the Council approve the European Parliament's position, as set out in PE-CONS-99/14, as an "A" item at a forthcoming meeting.

If the Council approves the European Parliament's position, the legislative act will be adopted.

After being signed by the President of the European Parliament and the President of the Council, the legislative act will be published in the Official Journal of the European Union.
