Subject:	Proposal for a Directive of the European Parliament and of the Council facilitating cross-border exchange of information on road safety related traffic offences(first reading)
	- Adoption of the legislative act (LA + S)

- On 18 July 2014 the Commission sent the above proposal, based on Article 91(1) TFEU, to 1. the Council.
- The European Economic and Social Committee delivered its opinion on 15 October 2014². 2. The Committee of the Regions was consulted.
- 3. The European Parliament adopted its position at first reading on the Commission proposal on 11 February 2015. The outcome of voting in the European Parliament reflects the compromise agreement reached between the institutions and should, therefore, be acceptable to the Council³.

- 4. The Permanent Representatives Committee is therefore asked to confirm its agreement and to suggest that the Council:
 - approve the European Parliament's position, as set out in PE-CONS 103/14, as an "A" item at a forthcoming meeting, with the United Kingdom delegation abstaining;
 - order that the statements in the <u>addendum</u> to this note be entered in the minutes of that meeting.

If the Council approves the European Parliament's position, the legislative act will be adopted.

After being signed by the President of the European Parliament and the President of the Council, the legislative act will be published in the Official Journal of the European Union.
