Subject: Proposal for a Regulation of the European Parliament and of the Council concerning type-approval requirements for the deployment of the eCall in-vehicle system and amending Directive 2007/46/EC (**first reading**)
- Adoption of
(a) the Council's position
(b) the statement of the Council's reasons

1. On 13 June 2013 the Commission sent the above proposal ¹, based on Article 114 TFEU, to the Council.
2. The European Economic and Social Committee delivered its opinion on 19 September 2013 ². The European Data Protection Supervisor delivered his opinion on 29 October 2013 ³.
3. The European Parliament adopted its position at first reading on 26 February 2014 ⁴.

4. At its 3363rd meeting on 17 December 2014, the Environment Council reached political agreement on the position of the Council at first reading on the aforementioned Regulation ¹.
 5. The Permanent Representatives Committee is asked to suggest that the Council adopt its position at first reading as set out in 5130/15 and the statement of reasons set out in 5130/15 ADD 1 as an "A" item at a forthcoming meeting, with the United Kingdom delegation voting against.
