- 2. The European Data Protection Supervisor delivered his opinion on 31 May 2013 <sup>5</sup>.
- 3. The European Parliament adopted its position at first reading on 25 February 2014 <sup>6</sup>.
- 4. At its 3433rd meeting on 3 December 2015, the Council (Justice and Home Affairs) reached political agreement on the Council's position at first reading on the above Regulation <sup>7</sup>.
- 5. The Permanent Representatives Committee is asked to suggest that the Council:
  - adopt, as an 'A' item at a forthcoming meeting, the Council's position at first reading as set out in 14957/15 and the statement of reasons as set out in 14957/15 ADD 1;
  - order that the statements in the addendum to this note be entered in the minutes of that meeting.
