	 Adoption of the Council's position at first reading and of the statement of the Council's reasons

- On 28 May 2018 the <u>Commission</u> sent its proposal¹, based on Article 192(1) TFEU, to the Council.
- 2. The European Economic and Social Committee delivered its opinion on 12 December 2018².
- 3. The <u>Committee of the Regions</u> delivered its opinion on 6 December 2018³.
- 4. The <u>European Parliament</u> adopted its position at first reading on 12 February 2019⁴.

- On 18 February 2020, the <u>Council</u> reached a political agreement on the Council's position at first reading on the above draft Regulation⁵.
- 6. The <u>Permanent Representatives Committee</u> is asked to suggest that the <u>Council</u>:
 - adopt its position at first reading, as set out in document 15301/19 and the statement of reasons, as set out in document 15301/19 ADD 1, as an 'A' item at a forthcoming meeting, with Germany and Slovakia abstaining;
 - decide that the statements in <u>Addendum 1</u> to this note be entered in the minutes of that meeting.
