- 1. On 31 May 2017 the <u>Commission</u> sent its proposal¹, based on Article 91(1) TFEU, to the Council.
- 2. The <u>European Economic and Social Committee</u> delivered its opinion on 18 January 2018 ².
- 3. The <u>Committee of the Regions</u> delivered its opinion on 1 February 2018 ³.

 - adopt its position at first reading, as set out in document 5112/20 and the statement of reasons, as set out in document 5112/20 ADD 1, as an 'A' item at a forthcoming meeting, with <u>BG/EE/CY/LV/LT/HU/MT/PL/RO</u> voting against;
 - decide that the statements in <u>Addendum 1</u> to this note be entered in the minutes of that meeting.
