The Mission of the Principality of Liechtenstein to the European Union presents its compliments to the General Secretariat of the Council and has the honour to refer to the notification by the Council of 30 June 2021, which reads as follows:

‘In accordance with the Protocol signed between the European Union, the European Community, the Swiss Confederation and the Principality of Liechtenstein on the accession of the Principality of Liechtenstein to the Agreement between the European Union, the European Community and the Swiss Confederation on the Swiss Confederation’s association with the implementation, application and development of the Schengen acquis, and with the first sentence of Article 5(2)(a) of the Protocol, the Principality of Liechtenstein is herewith notified of the adoption of the following acts:

REGULATION (EU) 2021/1150 OF THE EUROPEAN PARLIAMENT AND OF THE COUNCIL of 7 July 2021 amending Regulations (EU) 2018/1862 and (EU) 2019/818 as regards the establishment of the conditions for accessing other EU information systems for the purposes of the European Travel Information and Authorisation System

This exchange of notes will enter into force on the date of the notification by the Principality of Liechtenstein of the fulfilment of its constitutional requirements.
