## 'I/A' ITEM NOTE

Subject:	Draft Regulation of the European Parliament and of the Council in order to allow for the continuation of the territorial cooperation programmes PEACE IV (Ireland-United Kingdom) and United Kingdom-Ireland (Ireland-Northern Ireland-Scotland) in the context of the withdrawal of the United Kingdom from the Union (first reading) - Adoption of the legislative act

- On 20 December 2018 <u>the Commission</u> sent the above proposal<sup>1</sup>, based on Article 178 TFEU, to the Council.
- 2. <u>The European Economic and Social Committee</u> delivered its opinion on 20 February 2019<sup>2</sup>.
- 3. <u>The Committee of the Regions</u> was consulted.
- 4. On 13 March 2019 the <u>European Parliament</u> adopted its position at first reading on the Commission proposal. The outcome of voting in the European Parliament reflects the compromise agreement reached between the institutions and should, therefore, be acceptable to the Council<sup>3</sup>.

 The Permanent Representatives Committee is therefore asked to confirm its agreement and to suggest that the Council approve the European Parliament's position, as set out in PE-CONS 12/19, as an "A" item at a forthcoming meeting.

If the Council approves the European Parliament's position, the legislative act will be adopted.

After being signed by the President of the European Parliament and the President of the Council, the legislative act will be published in the Official Journal of the European Union.
