
**Proposal for a Directive of the European Parliament and of the Council on uniform procedures for checks on the transport of dangerous goods by road (codification)  
COM(2021) 483 of 19.8.2021 - 2021/0275 (COD)**

Having regard to the Interinstitutional Agreement of 20 December 1994 on an accelerated working method for official codification of legislative texts, and in particular to point 4 thereof, the Consultative Working Party consisting of the respective legal services of the European Parliament, the Council and the Commission met on 27 October 2021 for the purpose of examining the aforementioned proposal submitted by the Commission.

At that meeting<sup>1</sup>, an examination of the proposal for a Directive of the European Parliament and of the Council codifying Council Directive 95/50/EC of 6 October 1995 on uniform procedures for checks on the transport of dangerous goods by road resulted in the Consultative Working Party's concluding, without dissent, that the proposal is a straightforward codification of existing texts, without any change in their substance.
