Subject: Draft Regulation of the European Parliament and of the Council on cross-border parcel delivery services (**first reading**) -  
- Adoption of the legislative act

---

1. On 26 May 2016 the Commission sent the above proposal<sup>1</sup>, based on Article 114 TFEU, to the Council.
2. The Committee of the Regions was consulted.
3. The European Economic and Social Committee delivered its opinion on 2 February 2017<sup>2</sup>.

4. The European Parliament adopted its position at first reading on the Commission proposal on 13 March 2018. The outcome of voting in the European Parliament reflects the compromise agreement reached between the institutions and should, therefore, be acceptable to the Council<sup>3</sup>.
5. The Permanent Representatives Committee is therefore asked to confirm its agreement and to suggest that the Council approve the European Parliament's position, as set out in PE-CONS 69/17, as an 'A' item at a forthcoming meeting.

If the Council approves the European Parliament's position, the legislative act will be adopted.

After being signed by the President of the European Parliament and the President of the Council, the legislative act will be published in the Official Journal of the European Union.
