Subject:	Draft REGULATION OF THE EUROPEAN PARLIAMENT AND OF THE COUNCIL on data collection and sharing relating to short-term accommodation rental services and amending Regulation (EU) 2018/1724 (first reading)
	- Adoption of the legislative act

- 1. On 7 November 2022 the Commission submitted its proposal<sup>1</sup>, based on Article 114 TFEU, to the Council.
- 2. The <u>European Data Protection Supervisor</u> delivered its opinion on 16 December 2022<sup>2</sup>.
- 3. The European Economic and Social Committee delivered its opinion on 22 February 2023<sup>3</sup>.
- The Committee of the Regions delivered its opinion on 15 March 2023<sup>4</sup>. 4.

- 5. On 29 February 2024 the European Parliament adopted its position at first reading on the Commission proposal<sup>5</sup>. The outcome of voting in the European Parliament reflects the compromise agreement reached between the institutions and should, therefore, be acceptable to the Council.
- 6. The Permanent Representatives Committee is therefore asked to confirm its agreement and to suggest that the Council approve the European Parliament's position, as set out in PE-CONS 77/23, as an "A" item at a forthcoming meeting.
- 7. If the <u>Council</u> approves the European Parliament's position, the legislative act will be adopted.

After being signed by the Presidents of the European Parliament and of the Council, the legislative act will be published in the Official Journal of the European Union.
