Subject:	Draft Regulation of the European Parliament and of the Council amending Regulation (EU) No 2016/1036 on protection against dumped imports from countries not members of the European Union and Regulation (EU) 2016/1037 on protection against subsidised imports from countries not members of the European Union (first reading)
	 Adoption of the Council's position at first reading and of the statement of the Council's reasons

- 1. On 11 April 2013, the Commission sent the above proposal¹, based on Article 207(2) TFEU, to the Council.
- 2. The European Parliament adopted its position at first reading on 16 April 2014².
- 3. On 30 January 2018, the Chair of the European Parliament's Committee on International Trade sent a letter to the Chair of Coreper stating that the European Parliament was expected, at second reading, to approve the Council's position at first reading (following finalisation by legal/linguistic experts) without amendments.

Subsequently, on 7 February 2018, the Permanent Representatives Committee approved a compromise text after informal contacts had taken place between the Council and the European Parliament.

- 4. The Permanent Representatives Committee is asked to suggest that the Council:
 - adopt the Council's position at first reading as set out in 5700/18 and the statement of reasons as set out in 5700/18 ADD 1 as an 'A' item at a forthcoming meeting, with the United Kingdom and Spanish delegations voting against;
 - order that the statements in the addendum to this note be entered in the minutes of that meeting.
