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Subject:	Proposal for a Council Regulation amending Regulation (EU) No 216/2013 on the electronic publication of the Official Journal of the European Union - Agreement in principle - Request for the consent of the European Parliament

1. On 22 June 2020, the Commission submitted to the Council a proposal for a Council Regulation amending Regulation (EU) No 216/2013 on the electronic publication of the Official Journal of the European Union.
2. Delegations made comments in writing over the autumn of 2020.
3. The text was then discussed in the meeting of the Working Party on e-Law (e-Law) on 17 December 2020.
4. Following remarks by Member States, the text had to be reworked over the course of 2021 and 2022.

5. Delegations confirmed their agreement on the revised text at the level of the Working Party on e-Justice on 15 February 2023. All expressed scrutiny reservations have been lifted.
 6. The text has been subjected for revision by the lawyer-linguists of the Council. The resulting text is set out in document 6551/23.
 7. In light of the above, Coreper/Council is invited to:
 - a) agree in principle on the proposed Regulation, as set out in 6551/23, subject to the consent of the European Parliament;
 - b) decide to forward the draft text of the Regulation as set out in 6551/23 to the European Parliament for consent in accordance with Article 352 TFEU.
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
